Cooperation Protocol in the Area of
Legal and Judicial Training
Between

First Party :

The Council of State (a Judicial entity) located at 2 Essam El-Dali street, Giza City, The Arab Republic of Egypt , represented , for the purposes of this Agreement , by the Honorable Counselor Dr. Abdel-Rahman Othman Azouz, President of the council;

Second Party :

SUNSGLOW - LEGAL TRAINING IN THE RULE OF LAW (hereinafter referred to as “ SUNSGLOW “) , headquartered in NewYork city , U. S . A, represented for the purposes of this Agreement, by Dr. Yassin El-Ayouty , Esquire founder and president of SUNSGLOW , and professor Dr. Anwar Ahmed Raslan, Director of the Regional Center of SUNSGLOW , Cairo , Cairo University, Faculty of Law .

Preamble

Whereas a training symposium entitled “ Legal and Judicial Training “ has been held at the Cairo University , Faculty of law , the Regional center of SUNSGLOW , an activity in which several of the center of SUNSGLOW , an activity in which several of the Judges of the Council of State participated;

Whereas the leadership of SUNSGLOW expressed their readiness to enter into a cooperation agreement with Egypt's Council of State in the area of legal and judicial training , and

Whereas this worthy initiative has been received with reciprocal readiness on the part of the Council of State in view of the council's belief in the importance of legal and judicial training which is regarded as a continuous activity contributing to the general improvement of judicial performance ;

The two Parties have agreed as follows:

Item one :

The aforementioned preamble constitutes an integral part of this protocol, thus complementing it and contributing to its elucidation whenever necessary.

Item two :

The two parties have agreed that the second party shall strive to undertake and organize specialized training activities for legal and judicial training for the Honorable Judges of the Council of State , in subjects relevant to the legal and judicial work of the Council of State including but not limited to :

- 1- The system of administrative justice ;
- 2- Problems of the judicial system which face judges and litigants , and the proposed solutions thereto , especially in the light of the experiences of other States ;
- 3- Enhancement of the capacities and performance of Judges of the Council of State in legal areas with an international character and which touch upon the

- economic and social conditions of Egypt , such as international trade agreements , free trade, state contracts , and alternative dispute resolution (A D R) ;
- 4- Enhancement of the performance of the Judges of the Council of State when dealing with the areas of rights and freedoms and of international agreements related thereto .

Item Three:

Exchange of experiences and internships in legal and judicial entities such as:

- Courts;
- Centers for Judicial Studies;
- Regional and international arbitration centers; and
- Law schools.

Item Four:

The two parties agreed that, in addition to what has been stated above, cooperation between them shall also extend to any other area of activity which may be relevant to the achievement of their common purposes.

Item Five:

This protocol has been drafted, in four copies, in both Arabic and English, both of which have the same authenticity and evidentiary acceptability.


